This program empowers workforce to transform institutional aged care homes into places that support residents by creating opportunities for meaningful life.

We train your staff to create supportive environments, whether that means working with what you have or planning a refurbishment. It starts with a team of staff who want to explore their pivotal role in 'remaking' environments around the needs of residents. The end result might be a place that people can move around more easily, get outdoors or make a cup of tea.

The program is structured around three stages of project-based learning from group formation to the application of evidence-based practice. It is tailored to your organisation with a mix of online learning, virtual classrooms, and

site-based training. As the program progresses our trainers come to your site to work with your team in a manner that focuses on their reality. The program lasts between one and six months depending on your need and preferences and is available nationwide for metro, rural and remote sites.

By taking part in this program, you'll not only transform your organisations physical spaces, but also positively impact the lives of those in your care.
